

Student Leadership Role Description

STUDENT HOUSE LEADER

Role Purpose

- To lead their House Prefect team and the students in their House by demonstrating positive behaviours and acting as role models for all years.
- To support their House Leader in promoting the ethos of their House.

Key Responsibilities

- To lead, support and participate in House events and initiatives. Including Inter-House competitions and charity work.
- To contribute to the effective running of the House, as directed by any staff member.
- To conduct break/lunch duties as per the agreed rota.
- To lead PD sessions and model PD activities as directed by staff members.
- To mentor younger students.
- To lead various initiatives / schemes as directed by their House Leader.
- To contribute to House Assemblies as directed by their House Leader.
- To produce a half termly newsletter that will be shared with students of the House.
- To lead the updating of the House Notice Boards with events and information that is relevant to students within the house.
- To lead House Prefect meetings and attend other scheduled meetings as required.

Expectations

- Student House Leaders will need to have the ability to work productively with others, whilst using their initiative and originality to contribute to the positive ethos of the school and their House.
- Student House Leaders must be organised, responsible and enthusiastic. They should be a great ambassador for the school.
- Student House Leaders must maintain excellent behaviour, uniform, attendance and punctuality.
- Student House Leaders must ensure that they check their school email on a regular basis for communications.

Should a Student House Leader fail to meet any of the responsibilities or expectations on this document they may have their role removed.
