

MATHS CURRICULUM AREA

Our Maths Team of 15 specialist teachers is led by Pete Jordan. He was appointed to the role of Learning Leader in 2017 after a number of years as the Deputy Learning Leader of Maths.

The Maths GCSE results have been consistently excellent over the past 5 years: 30% of students achieving grade 7 and above, 65% achieving grade 5 and above, and 84% achieving grade 4 and above in 2017. Current Year 11 are poised to replicate the same success.

The Maths Department is a highly collaborative team, with a strong track record of developing and supporting new teachers, in a coaching culture. Continuing professional development and engagement with research and evidence is at the heart of improvements in our students' experience and achievement in Maths.

Students are ambitious, enjoy Maths, and want to learn, and we continue to look for ways to inspire and engage learners through improved aspects of teaching and refined classroom practice.

The Maths Curriculum Area is located in 13 dedicated classrooms, each with their own interactive whiteboard and projector. Each teacher is allocated a laptop and there is also access around the school to multiple computer suites.
