### What do I have to do?

You will be required to create a Final Outcome (Final Piece) for one of your projects. This should be started in the exam, but does not necessarily need to be finished, as we would prefer you to be ambitious in your ideas. The 5hrs should give you a good indication of how much work you will be able to achieve in 10hrs.

As per Exam guidelines you will need to hand in your project sketchbook at the end of the Exam. This will be marked in conjunction with your Mock Exam final piece.

### How will I be assessed?

You will be marked out of 96 total. Each assessment objective will be marked out of 24.

A01: Connections to Artists and Sources, Ideas

A02: Development, Experimentation with Media, Final Piece Planning

A03: Skill

A04: Final Outcome and connection to all three strands above.

How can I prepare/revise?

- Bring all materials with you on the day/make sure your Art teacher can have them available
- Ensure that you have any images you need. You will not be able to use the computers. If you need these enlarged, then please get these to your teacher beforehand.
- Complete your project sketchbook to the best possible standard.
- Ensure you have a fully planned and developed final piece idea – discussed with your Art Teacher beforehand.
