### What do I have to do?

You will be required to create a Final Outcome (Final Piece) for one of your projects. (for most of you this will be Project 3, for some of you Project 2). This should be completed in the Exam. We would like you to be ambitious in your ideas. The 5hrs should give you a good indication of how much work you will be able to achieve in 10hrs.

As per Exam guidelines you will need to hand in your project sketchbook/PPT at the end of the Exam. This will be marked in conjunction with your Mock Exam final piece.

### How will I be assessed?

You will be marked out of 96 total. Each assessment objective will be marked out of 24.

A01: Connections to Artists and Sources, Ideas

A02: Development, Experimentation with Media, Final Piece Planning

A03: Skill

A04: Final Outcome and connection to all three strands above.

### How can I prepare/revise?

- Bring all materials with you on the day/make sure your Photography teacher can have them available
- Get all printing done before hand – see your Photography teacher/Mr Reeves in reprographics for help.
- Ensure that you have any images you need.
- Complete your project sketchbook/PPT to the best possible standard.
- Ensure you have a fully planned and developed final piece idea – discussed with your Photography Teacher beforehand.
- Any photos on phones need to be placed on the school system prior to the exam.

You will not be able to use phones/listen to music or use the internet during this exam.
