

## Student Leadership Role Description

### HOUSE PREFECT

#### Role Purpose

- To lead the students in their House by demonstrating positive behaviours and acting as role models for all years.
- To support their Student House Leaders and House Leader in promoting the ethos of their House.

#### Key Responsibilities

- To support and participate in House events and initiatives. Including Inter-House competitions and charity work.
- To contribute to the effective running of the House, as directed by any staff member.
- To conduct break/lunch duties as per the agreed rota
- To lead PD sessions and model PD activities as directed by staff members.
- To mentor younger students.
- To collaborate on various initiatives / schemes as directed by their Student House Leaders.
- To contribute to House Assemblies.
- To update the House Notice Boards with information and news relevant to the house.
- To attend to scheduled meetings.

#### Expectations

- House Prefects will need to have the ability to work productively with others, whilst using their initiative and originality to contribute to the positive ethos of the school and their House.
- House Prefects must be organised, responsible and enthusiastic. They should be a great ambassador for the school.
- House Prefects must maintain excellent behaviour, uniform, attendance and punctuality.
- House Prefects must ensure that they check their school email on a regular basis for communications.
